The CSG Committee on Suggested State Legislation convened Friday, December 5 from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, December 6 from 8:15 until 10:30 a.m. These meetings comprised the first set in the 2010 SSL Cycle.

Steve Gregory, CSG Chief Legal Officer, opened the Friday meeting with an update about CSG efforts to get states to award Continuing Legal Education Credits (CLEs) to attorneys who attend SSL Committee meetings. The goal is to get future SSL Committee meetings approved in advance for CLEs by at least one state, and eventually, at least one state in every CSG region. CSG staff would combine the accrediting documentation from such states with a generic package of materials that SSL Committee meeting attendees could use to apply for CLEs within their respective states after the SSL meeting. A small group of SSL Committee members and CSG leaders are working with CSG staff to move this process forward.

There were 102 bills on the SSL Committee docket for these meetings. The bills addressed a variety of timely issues, including global warming and sustainable cities. The Committee voted to include 31 bills in the 2010 Suggested State Legislation Volume. It deferred 5 bills for further consideration. It rejected the remaining 66 bills.

The SSL Committee will meet next at the CSG spring 2009 meeting in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. March 1, 2009 is the deadline to submit legislation to that docket.

Finally, the CSG Technology Working Group and the CSG Transportation Advisory Group began reviewing technology and transportation-related legislation on SSL dockets. Doing this enables CSG to take advantage of these groups' expertise; engages the working groups in producing a core CSG product; and is consistent with practices followed by CSG policy task forces.
