The CSG Committee on Suggested State Legislation convened Friday, November 13, from 1:30 until 4:00 p.m., and Saturday, November 14, from 9:00 until 11:00. These meetings comprise the first set in the 2011 SSL Cycle. There were 98 bills on the SSL Committee docket. The bills addressed a variety of timely issues, including carbon sequestration and distracted driving.

The Committee voted to include 24 bills in the 2011 Suggested State Legislation Volume. It deferred 1 bill for further consideration, and it rejected the remaining 73 bills. The SSL Committee meets next at the CSG spring 2010 meeting in New York City.

There were no action items from this committee.
